## ENTERTAINER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

### **Date and Hours of Operation**

Sacramento Aloha Festival will be open to the general public on Saturday, September 17, 2022 from 10:00 am to 7:00 pm. Gates open at 9:30 am; opening ceremony is at 10:30 am.

### **Admission**

2022 admission charge is \$5.00, children 10-under and seniors 65+ are free. Entertainers may request complimentary admission tickets for all performers and required assistants. Other hālau members and family members do not receive complimentary admission. However you may request an admission ticket for an adult who is transporting a child performer. Remember, admission tickets are only required for ages 11-64.

Admission tickets will be mailed ~2 weeks prior to the event. No changes are allowed to admission ticket requests after August 20, 2022.

### **Decorations**

Wire cables are affixed to the perimeter walls of each building to hang decorative and other like materials. Do NOT use nails, staples, tape, etc. on wall surfaces, floor, or stage. Thumbtacks or pins, if removed, are allowed. Failure to comply with the above provisions may result in damage charges being levied.

Any nail, tack, or hole, etc. found in the Auburn Host Lions Building and/or Barefoot Wine and Bubbly Stage walls will be subject to a \$1000 charge from Gold Country Fairgrounds per blemish found and will be the responsibility of the offender.

### **Festival Liability**

Involvement in the Sacramento Aloha Festival is at your own risk. All entertainers will agree to and sign the Hold Harmless Agreement that is made a part of this application.

### **General Medical Information**

- First-aid will be available at the SAFC Information Booth.
- Only service pets will be allowed in Gold Country Fairgrounds and Event Center.
- Smoking is confined to designated smoking areas in the upper parking lot.
