

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The mission of the Ka'ōnohi Foundation as a non-profit 501(c)(3) is to demonstrate, embody and perpetuate the culture of Hawai'i for the present and future generations and to promote scholastic and cultural education for all who volunteer at the Sacramento Aloha Festival.

Application Deadlines:

- College/Trade School Students: October 1
- High School Seniors: May 1

Area of Study:	Any Major
School:	The scholarship may be designated either to college or certified trade schools.
Scholarship:	\$500.00

Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be a senior in high school, a college student, or trade school student.
- 2. Applicant must successfully complete eight hours as a volunteer at the Sacramento Aloha Festival.

Requirements:

- 1. Applicants must provide proof of enrollment at a college or trade/vocational school.
- 2. College students must maintain a minimum of six units each quarter or semester.
- 3. Trade or professional school recipients must maintain the equivalent to six units.
- 4. Applicants must maintain a grade "C" or higher in all courses. In the event a student obtains a grade lower than a "C" or a deficiency from their vocational school, the applicant will not qualify for future scholarships from the Ka'onohi Foundation.
- 5. Applicants will be automatically disqualified from the review process if application is incomplete.
- 6. Please attach a current photo of yourself.

A Scholarship committee of qualified individuals will review and rate each application. Current college/trade school students will be notified by letter by October 15 following the Sacramento Aloha Festival. High school students will be notified by June 1.
